

## MICRO ART RAFFLE

Accepted artists must contribute one piece of artwork per each day of participation for the Micro Art Raffle. The donated artwork should be reflective of what is exhibited that day, and not to exceed 12 inches in any dimensions.

## ENTRY FEES

Ten tents will be available each day for artists to display and sell their works of art. Tent availability is limited and pricing is based on the number of days each artist is participating, as follows:

- One Days: \$45
  - Two Days: \$85
  - Three Days: \$120\*
  - All Four Days: \$150\*
- \*Shemer members receive \$5 off.

Call Shemer Art Center today to reserve your space. Once confirmed payment may be made online through PayPal or by credit card. You may also stop by to pay in person or mail a check made out to "Shemer Art Center." Your entry will not be deemed complete until payment has been received. Eligibility is open to the first 10 reservations as space is limited. This is a non-judicial event.

## SALES

Artists retain 100% of profits made from the artwork sales in their booths.
