He finished a MFA from Temple University in 2010. He has worked at the Corning Museum of Glass, the American Museum of Natural History, the New Orleans School of Glassworks, as well as Wet Dog Glass as an equipment fabricator. He has been an instructor at the University of Miami, studios across the country, and has exhibited his work nationally and internationally. In 2015 Fairweather launched the first accredited glass blowing program at Paradise Valley Community College in Phoenix, Arizona, where he continues to teach.

MEDIA

All work must be predominantly glass, ranging from maquettes to monumental in all styles and traditions. Open to any and all types of glass art forms.

EXHIBITION DETAILS

- 1. Artist must be an Arizona resident and at least 18 years of age.
- 2. Work must be:
 - Original
 - · Predominantly glass
- 3. Outdoor Installations:
 - Suitable for outdoor installation.
 - Structurally secure.
 - Capable of withstanding adverse weather conditions and high traffic areas.
 - Must also be safe for children
 - Cannot exceed 15 feet in height or 500 pounds.
 - Due to the limitations of the equipment available to the Shemer Art Center, prior installation arrangements must be made.
 - Works deemed unsafe, overly fragile or otherwise unsuitable will not be considered for the exhibition.
- 4. Indoor Installations
 - Cannot exceed 5 feet in height, 2 feet in width and 200 pounds.
 - Hanging work should not weigh more than 50 pounds. All work accepted for the exhibition must be ready to hang.
- Selected artists may be invited to submit at least three photographs, drawings, sketches or other material suitable for display depicting the creative process or the work in progress.
