About the Juror

Seth Fairweather began working with glass at Tulane University in New Orleans, Louisiana. He transferred to Alfred University, where he received his BFA in 2007 and went on to complete an MFA from Temple University in 2010.

He has worked at the Corning Museum of Glass, the American Museum of Natural History, the New Orleans School of Glassworks, and Wet Dog Glass as an equipment fabricator. He has taught at the University of Miami as well as studios across the country, and has exhibited his work nationally and internationally.

In 2015 Fairweather launched the first accredited glass blowing program at Paradise Valley Community College in Phoenix, where he continues to teach today.
